



Margaret Cornell Sullivan

December 20, 1928 - November 11, 2007

Margaret A. Cornell Sullivan, age 78 years, 10 months, and 22 days of age, passed away on Sunday, November 11, 2007 at her home after a 21 year battle with cancer.

Margaret was born on December 20, 1928 in Cedar County, Missouri to Everett and Ruth Owen Price.

On August 29, 1948 she married Paul Cornell of Aldrich, MO. They moved to Idaho where their two sons were born, Terry Kent and Paul DeLen. They lived in Idaho 12 years before moving back to Missouri in 1961. Paul passed away on July 11, 1988.

She married Harlan Hopkins on December 16, 1991. Harland passed away on May 7, 1994. On November 25, 1996 Margaret married Willard Sullivan who survives her.

Margaret worked at a lot of different jobs in her lifetime. She helped Paul in the Seed Business several years. Her last work was being a Tax Accountant. She owned her own business office. She retired in 2001.

Proceeding her in death besides her two husbands were her father, mother, and her brother James, and two infant twin grandsons.

Margaret was saved in a brush shed meeting when she was 11 years old. She joined Oak Grove Missionary Baptist Church in Cedar County. At the time of her death she belonged to Southside Missionary Baptist Church in Bolivar, MO.
