Marie Cecilia (Sukovaty)Bright (February 8, 1921 - April 18, 2015) Marie Bright, 94, of Bolivar passed away Saturday, April 18, 2015. She was one of 9 children born in Tobias, Nebraska to Frank and Cecilia Rut. Marie was a graduate of the Tobias High School Class of 1939. She married Ludvik S. Sukovaty on October 6, 1943 at the St. Joseph Church in Tobias and they were blessed with 5 children. The family moved from Lincoln, Nebraska to Bolivar in 1958. Her husband Ludvik passed away in 1961. Marie married Elmer (Al) Bright on August 6th, 1985. She was a 4-H leader with the Woodlawn 4-H Club for many years. She enjoyed cooking and baking and was known in local circles as the "kolache" queen. She liked to do handwork crocheting afgans and embroidering tea towels for her children and grandchildren. She was deft at solving word search puzzles and enjoyed reading which kept her mind active.
