



Rev. Marshall C. Parker

December 16, 1922 - April 1, 2011

Rev. Marshall Cleveland Parker, 88, of Flemington passed away April 1, 2011. He was born December 16, 1922 in Elkton to Rufus Cleveland and Mary Nora (Whitlock) Parker. A veteran of World War II he served in the U. S. Army Air Corps from December 9, 1942 to November 1945 with the rank of corporal. He was called by God to preach in the spring of 1991 and reopened the Flemington Christian Church where he served as pastor. He was preceded in death by a grandson, Ralph Parker II, a brother, Marvin Parker, and 2 sisters, Margaret (Peg) Szegedin and Marjorie Holcroft. Marshall is survived by his wife of 28 years, Dortha Elizabeth (Blackwell) Parker; 3 children, Marsha Maples, Independence, Ralph Parker, Kansas City, and Dan Parker, Raymore; 2 step-children, Rhonda DeHaemers, Independence and Randy Box, Raytown and many grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
