Martina Mitchell was born to Walter Robert Regenbrecht Sr. and Helen Grace (Hurst) Regenbrecht on July 21, 1942, in Independence Missouri. She attended school in Independence and graduated from William Chrisman High School in 1960. Later that year while working at Sears she met and married the love of her life James Doyle Mitchell. To this union five children were born: Carrie, Glen, Renee, Richard and Sarah.

She was saved as a teenager in a small church in Independence. While sitting with her friends the Lord drew her to the altar.
