Merle F. Burbaugh Sr, 89, of Flemington, Missouri left this world on January 8, 2013. He was born the eldest of 5 children to Eurotis W. and Lillian Mather Burbaugh in Marion, Ohio. Merle was a WWII veteran where he proudly served his country in war zones as a Merchant Marine. He worked 35 years for Cummins Diesel, living in many states before retiring as Branch Manager for Cummins Diesel in Springfield. He was of the Methodist faith. He belonged to the AmVets Post 114 in Flemington. Merle was an interesting man, often called "Merlin" by his friends and family because he seemed to be able to create any sort of mechanical contraption to suit his needs and had the ability to repair or fix anything. He was a fisherman and loved teaching his children how to fish, boat, and camp. He loved to cook. He liked the outdoors, enjoyed playing golf, and was a licensed pilot for small aircraft.
