Milford Ray Chancellor, 88, of Hollister, Missouri, passed away Saturday, May 5, 2012, at the Point Lookout Nursing and Rehab in Hollister. He was born in Carnegie, Oklahoma, the son of James and Mary Van Dovie Nance Chancellor. Ray moved from Oklahoma to west Texas and then to Houston, Texas, before moving to the Humansville-Stockton area. He worked as a mechanic at various times and retired from the MFA Exchange, Stockton. He married Tillie Mae Myers on March 10, 1968 and she preceded him in death March 12, 2012, after 40 years together. Ray was a U.S. Army veteran serving in WWII as a tank commander under Gen. George S. Patton and entered Berlin with General Patton, a moment he was fond of recalling. He enjoyed working and after retirement continued to enjoy going to the MFA Exchange just to visit. He loved his cats and when he moved to Hollister 3 years ago to be near his son Ronnie Whitehead, the cats went also. Ray was preceded in death by his wife, his parents, brothers Pete and Lee Chancellor and sister Dovie B. Chancellor. He is survived by sons Ronnie Whitehead and wife Debbie of Hollister; Larry Bates of Humansville; Donald Chancellor of Midland, Texas; Harold Chancellor, Odessa, Texas; daughters Gail Keener and husband Buster of Pep, New Mexico; Delinda Beatty, Odessa, Texas; many grandchildren and several great-grandchildren. Gravesite services will be held 10:00 AM Wednesday, May 9th at Old Union Cemetery near Stockton with Rev. Kent Reel officiating.
