



## Myrtle Lorene McCoy

Myrtle Lorene McCoy, 84, of Flemington passed away Tuesday, September 17, 2013 at her daughter's residence in Marshfield, Missouri. She was one of 6 children born to James and Maude Richards. Myrtle and Clarence McCoy were married on December 7, 1946 and they were married for 61 years before his death on June 29, 2008. They lived in the Flemington area where Clarence owned and operated the Texaco Service Station.
