



Nellie LuCreta Wade

February 11, 1922 - July 23, 2009

Nellie LuCreta Wade, 87 of Bolivar, MO, died at 3:45 p.m. Thursday, July 23, 2009, in Parkview Healthcare facility.

LuCreta was born February 11, 1922, in Warrensburg, MO, the daughter of Thomas Harrison Miller and Nellie Marie Johnson Miller.

On July 7, 1946, LuCreta was united in marriage to Ira Delton Wade in a double wedding ceremony and to this union three children were born: Sherry LuCreta Wade Gezel; Marilyn Joanne Wade Haralson Page; and Kenneth Delton Wade.

LuCreta was a 1940 graduate of Nevada, MO. High School; an Airman in the Civil Air Patrol, Missouri Wing from Nevada during World War II; and served on several local community activities including a life-long member of the American Legion Ladies Auxiliary. After retirement, LuCreta and Delton enjoyed traveling and were members of the Hillbilly Rollers RV club. They also enjoyed playing cards with friends and family.

She became a member of the Bolivar First Christian Church and was baptized in Christ in 1961.

LuCreta and Delton owned and operated Wades Super Market in Bolivar for

several years and they were in the grocery business for 47 years.

LuCreta was preceded in death by her parents, three brothers, her husband Ira Delton Wade, and daughter Marilyn Joanne Wade Haralson Page, and son-in law Ralph Charles Haralson.
