He had spotted a small, black young man being slapped and bullied by three white men. Ollie went off on his own, with the rest of us then following not noticing through the crowd what was up. How he spotted what was going on I don't know. But once pushing his way through the crowd he pulled one of the three away from the man and told the others to stand back. The three stopped. At this point I had made it through the crowd. Ollie's hat must have fallen off during the scuffle. As I noticed Ollie going up to one of the three and snatching his hat back from that guy's head. After some words, the three then left through the crowd. I don't recall any more than that or if we even spoke to the bullied man. I just remember being confused as to why Ollie split to go to a different stage than the one we agreed upon. Then trying to follow him through the crowd as he was purposefully headed away from us. And then being struck by how he just went on his own against three others to help this person. No one else was helping the man up to this point. Ollie was the one soul who helped. Now, may his soul be blessed.
