June 13, 1930 - May 29, 2008

Ralph Alan Stauffacher, 77, Bolivar, was born to Walter and Vee Stauffacher June 13, 1930 near Humansville, Missouri. His wish to go home from the hospital was granted and he peacefully passed away there May 29, 2008 due to declining health.
