



Raymond William Roedder

February 17, 1930 - March 23, 2012

MSgt USAF Ret. Raymond William Roedder, 82, of Bolivar, died Friday, March 23, 2012, at the Missouri Veteran's Home in Mt. Vernon, Missouri, after a stay of 3 years. He was born in Jennings, Missouri, the oldest son of Raymond and Thelma Roedder. Raymond joined the military as a young man and served a total of 21 years in the US Army and US Air Force. After retiring from the military he attended SMSU and received a Bachelor's Degree in Accounting. Upon graduation he worked for Governor Christopher Bond and Attorney General John Ashcroft in Jefferson City, Missouri. The last 15 years of his working career were spent with the US Treasury Department. Upon retirement, Ray spent many years enjoying the workings of his small farm near Aldrich, Missouri, and taking coffee with the crowd at the Nifty Cafe in Bolivar. Ray was preceded in death by his parents, son Stephen Roedder, and brother Ronald Roedder of St. Louis. He is survived by his wife Virginia of the home; son Ricci W. Roedder and his wife Un Hui of Springfield; granddaughter, CPT Maralyn Campbell Roedder of Washinton, DC; grandson Timothy W. Roedder of Ft. Lauderdale, Florida; daughter-in-law Julie Roedder of Bremerton, Washington; sister Joyce McLeod of Londonderry, New Hampshire; and sister Sharon Roedder of Boston, Massachusetts.
