Robert Dale Albers, age 84, of Halfway, Missouri passed away on Thursday evening, June 16, 2011 at Citizens Memorial Healthcare Facility in Bolivar, Missouri after a courageous bout with cancer.

He was born on May 21, 1927 in Union, South Dakota to Herman Jacob Albers and Mary (Napier) Albers.

On July 1, 1948 he married Bonnie B. Sherwood in New Mexico.

Robert first served in the Merchant Marines, and then served in the United States Air Force for 20 years, retiring as Chief Master Sergeant in December 1972, having earned the coveted Bronze Star, among numerous other awards. He was a member and treasurer of the Halfway Lions Club and the American VFW Post in Buffalo, Missouri.
