Robert Lamar "Stob", 87, of Bolivar, MO passed away Tuesday, May 16, 2017 at CMH in Bolivar, MO. Our precious brother and uncle, Robert Lamar, went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday May 16, 2017. He was born on May 8, 1930 to Edd Lamar and Ethel Bennett Lamar. A lifelong citizen of Bolivar he still resided in the home in which he was born. Robert became a star athlete at Bolivar High School where he lettered in several sports. He was a stand out on the basketball team. He graduated in 1949. Robert helped construct the Coca-Cola plant before he joined the army and was shipped to Korea. During the Korean War, he was in the infantry and served on the front lines. When he returned to Bolivar he worked at the Coke plant. Soon after he took a job for a local pharmacy where he worked for three bosses for over 50 years delivering prescriptions to the residents of Polk County. Robert had countless friends in the community where he was affectionately known as 'Stob'. He regularly attended athletic events at the high school and in later years he was active at the Senior Center where he taught and played pool. He was devoted to his family and friends. Robert was preceded in death by his parents, three brothers, and one sister. He is survived by three sisters: Betty Collins (James) of Corpus Christi, TX, Patricia Jarman of Wichita, KS, Ruby Cacy of Antelope, CA and numerous nieces and nephews. He was lovingly cared for, in his final years, by his nieces Barbara Lamar Morgan, Harriet Lamar List, and his nephew Rick List. He will be greatly missed by all who knew and loved him.
