Robert Rex Polly, lifetime resident of Halfway, Missouri, passed from this life on Tuesday, October 20 at 1:00 p.m. in the wooded field north of his home. He was 53.

Robert was born the son of Dean Rexford Polly and Willa Mae (Matthews) Polly on October 10th, 1956 and lived one year in Huron, Missouri before moving to the Halfway community.

Bob, as he preferred to be called, was a master builder in the Polk County area and had been for many years, specializing in custom homes. He also maintained a herd of cows on the family farm. Bob loved the out-of-doors, farming, hunting, gardening, exploring, in fact, anything to do with nature.

He was united in marriage to Donna J. Campbell on September 17th, 1999 and to that union was born a son Gabriel Robert, 8, of the home, both of whom survive him.
