Robert (Bob) Lee Wooten age 81, of Bolivar, passed away July 5, 2013 in Manor Care nursing home in Springfield, MO following a short illness. He was born January 18, 1932 to Clarence Orville and Ora Ethel (Snodgrass) Wooten in Pleasant Hope, MO. He accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior as a teenager and was later baptized.
