Robert Lewis Wright, age 77, of Fair Play, Missouri passed away on Wednesday, November 11, 2009 at Golden Valley Memorial Hospital in Clinton, Missouri after suffering heart failure.

He was born September 23, 1932 in Aldrich, Missouri to Marvin Esley Wright and Thelma Lucille Courtney Wright.
