Rosalia Grace Newcomb, age 101 of Bolivar, Missouri passed away on Monday, September 20, 2010 at Citizens Memorial Hospital in Bolivar, Missouri.

She was born December 10, 1908 on a farm two miles Northwest of Parnell, Nodaway County, Missouri, the daughter of Charles Henry Newcomb and Louisa Catherine (Conway) Newcomb.

She worked on the farm and handled many of the farming chores. She attended First Assembly of God Church in Bolivar, Missouri. She moved to Polk County, Missouri in December of 1917 at the age of 9.
