Scott was born in Burlington, Vermont. He attended Bellows Free Academy Fairfax, and graduated in 1987. He immediately enlisted in the US Army.

Scott was a career service man, with almost 28 years of military service. Scott's talent and hard work helped him to move through the ranks, achieving Warrant Officer 2 (WO2). Scott was a veteran and served in Iraq.
