She was not only my sister, but also a best friend to whom I could tell secrets and as little sisters do sometimes, she would threaten to use this information to get what she wanted. She fought the battle of cancer until the end. She always had a good attitude about it. She would say, I may have cancer, but it doesn't have me. She received her miracle healing on March 4. She will be greatly missed by her family and friends. Sharon, Katie, we all love you and as the song said, we will meet you at Jesus feet. Funeral services will be at 3:00 PM Sunday, March 7, 2010 at Murray Funeral Home, Bolivar with Rev. Dan Rocha officiating. Visitation will be from 2:00 to 3:00 PM Sunday.
