Stephen Allen 'Steve' Norman age 65 of Willow Springs, MO passed away at 6:57 PM Saturday, June 9, 2012 at his home after an extended illness.

He was born on August 30, 1946 in Springfield, MO the son of Etcyle Boone Norman, Jr. and Genieve (Exline) Norman .

Steve was a 1964 graduate and Senior Class president of Ava High School and was very active in the basketball, baseball and football programs.

On May 1, 1974 in St. Louis, MO, Steve was united in marriage to Virginia M. Boyle and her family instantly became Steve's family and they had over 38 years together.

Steve enrolled in the St. Louis College Of Pharmacy for a couple of years, then joined the U. S. Army serving in Germany. After his discharge he returned to the College of Pharmacy and graduated and was also an Adjunct Clinical Instructor for the College. He was a member of the Willow Springs Church Of Christ of which he oversaw the building and construction of their new church a few years ago, the Willow Springs Rotary Club, Many other Willow Springs Organizations including Hometown PRIDE, Chamber Of Commerce, Ozarks Family YMCA, Community Betterment, Board Member of Community Foundation, Senior Housing, Arts Council, Saddle Club, Medical

Assistance Program.
