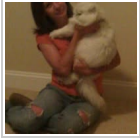

She was a very special person and I will miss her terribly. My prayers go out to the family in their time of sorrow.



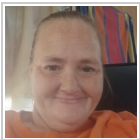

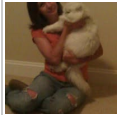

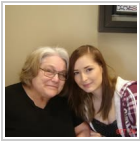
