Sybil Lois Wright, age 87, of Morrisville, Missouri passed away at 4:40pm, on Wednesday, June 18, 2008 at the Christian Healthcare Center in Republic, Missouri after a long illness.

She was born April 14, 1921 in Webbers Falls, Oklahoma, the daughter of Steamboat McGrew and Lilly Clemons McGrew.
