June 27, 1925 - July 15, 2013

Vernon C. Brown, 88, passed away Monday, July 15th at Lake Stockton Healthcare Facility. He was born in Brookfield, Missouri as one of 2 sons born to Sanford and Grace (Level) Brown. He spent his formative years living in the Excelsior Springs, Missouri area. Vernon enlisted in the US Navy and served in the Pacific Theatre during WWII. He was involved in the island hopping campaign and was present at the Liberation of the Philippines. He was at Iwo Jima and Guadalcanal. After his discharge from the Navy Vernon returned home and married the former Beverly "Carol" Herring. She preceded him in death on June 5, 2002. Vernon enlisted in the US Army in 1958 and served 2 tours of duty in Vietnam. After 16 years with the Army and 4 years with the Navy he retired from active military service in 1974 and settled at Flemington where he became active in farming. He enjoyed hunting, fishing and being outdoors. Vernon liked to travel and looked forward to the military reunions that he participated in every 2 years. He was a member of the Humansville United Methodist Church. Vernon was preceded in death by his parents and his wife Beverly. He is survived by daughter Sharon Anderson and her husband Sam of Humansville; son Vernon C. Brown II and his wife Shelby of Huntsville, Alabama; grandsons David and Tony Anderson and Nathan Mitchell; great-grandson Austin Mitchell; brother Gene Brown and his wife Liz of Tyler, Texas; sister-in-law Judy Logan of Nixa, Missouri; "adopted daughters" Tamara Locke and Suzanne Fust; many nieces and nephews. Funeral services for Vernon C. Brown will be held 2:00 PM Friday, July 19th at

Murray Funeral Home, Humansville officiated by Rev. Jeff Jaekley. Burial will follow at the Flemington Cemetery with full military honors.
