Vernon Alonzo Carter, 77, son of Edwin "Crum" and Bessie Frances Nasalroad Carter was born May 24, 1934, at the home in Goodson and departed this life Sunday, February 26, 2012. Vernon was saved at a young age at Goodson Church and later joined Pleasant Hill Baptist Church where he remained a member.
