August 11, 1938 - January 12, 2020

Virgil Dale Hughes, 81, was born on the family farm near Humansville, MO on August 11, 1938 to Otis Lyle Hughes and Lucy Jeanette (Womble) Hughes. He departed this earth on Sunday, January 12, 2020 at Lake Regional Hospital in Camdenton, MO.

Virgil graduated from Humansville High School in 1956. After serving in the U.S. Army he started working at the Humansville Bank. He worked there for 31 years and was President and CEO for over 25 years. In 1992, he was employed at the Citizens Bank in Amsterdam, MO. In 2015, he was appointed President of the Bank of Macks Creek and served on their board of directors. Virgil was a member of the Amsterdam Masonic Lodge #141 and had served as the past master of both the Amsterdam and Humansville Masonic Lodge #144.

Virgil is survived by his son, Jeffery Dale Hughes and fiancée Jessica Esteb of Osage Beach, MO, and since she was two years old, step-daughter Christina L. Hughes of San Pedro, CA. He is also survived by his grandson, Jackson Allen-Hughes, as well as brother Raymond Hughes and wife Doris of Bolivar, MO, sister-in-law Joyce Hughes of Humansville, Mo and sister in law Frieda Hughes of Sedalia, MO and several nieces, nephews and friends. He was preceded-in-death by his parents, brothers Darrel Lee and Donald Dean Hughes, and baby sister Addie Lavern Hughes.
