William H. Weakes, 80, Bolivar, died Saturday, May 3, 2008 at his home after a long, hard-fought battle with cancer. He was born January 20, 1928 to Claude and Evelyn (Register) Weakes at Eagle Lake, Florida. He grew up around the orange groves of Polk County, Florida. As a young man he entered the sheet metal trade and spent nearly 40 years in this vocation. He and Lou Ann Walker were married February 3, 1963. After his retirement you would never see one without the other. Bill and Lou Ann were the parents of one daughter, Lorie Ann. Bill spent all of his childhood and most of his adult life in Florida, before moving to South Carolina. After spending 9 years in South Carolina, he and Lou Ann moved to Missouri to be closer to their daughter and family. After being displaced by a tornado at Humansville, they settled near Rondo. It was here that he joined the Rondo Baptist Church. One of the milestones of Bill's life was being baptized on August 19, 2007, something he was determined to do before he lost his fight with cancer. Survivors include his wife of 45 years, Lou Ann, of the home; his daughter and son-in-law, Lorie Ann and Jerry Miles, Eldorado Springs; two grandchildren, Thomas Falconer and Jennifer Miles; one sister, Marjorie Smart, Lake Mary, Florida; 1 uncle, Louis Register, Eagle Lake, Florida; several nieces, nephews, other family and friends. Funeral services will be 5:00 PM Tuesday, May 6, 2008 in Murray Funeral Home, Humansville with Rev. Jack Sawyers officiating.
