Wilma Marie Holst Curry, Fair Play, passed away November 22, 2011, at Lake Stockton Nursing Home, Stockton. The daughter of Richard and Eva (Wilson) Holst, she was born in Kansas. Both her parents died while Wilma was small and she was raised by her grandparents. She was married to Gilford M. Curry who preceded her in death October 1, 1973. She was a homemaker and a cook at the Dunnegan School until the school closed. When the family later moved to Springfield, Wilma worked in the cafeteria at Evangel College until retirement when she moved to Fair Play.
