Wylla Irene Pitts, 86, of Humansville, passed away Monday, June 4, 2012, at her residence, the home of Billy Cleavinger and wife Tina where she had resided the past 2 years. She was born in Humansville, the daughter of Zeb and Margaret Pyeatt Wilkerson. She was a graduate of Humansville High School class of 1943. She moved to Kansas City where she worked at Pratt and Whitney during WWII for 2 years before her marriage to Jimmie B. Pitts in 1945. They moved to Independence, Missouri, and both Wylla and Jimmie worked for Sears-Roebuck Company until retiring in 1978. Wylla was an active member of New Salem Baptist Church in Independence for many years. She was church pianist for 10 years and was a Sunday School teacher. She loved gospel music and reading her Bible. They moved back to Humansville in 2003 and she became a member of First Baptist Church, Humansville. Jimmie passed away March 18, 2010, after 64 years of marriage and she was looking forward to being re-united with him in the presence of God where they would be forever together. Wylla was preceded in death by her parents, husband Jimmie Pitts, and sister Ruth Moffett. She is survived by her brother-in-laws Wendell D.
