



## Zodee Harris

February 14, 1929 - May 1, 2008

Zorene (Zodee) Harris, age 79, Bolivar, died at 8:00 AM, Thursday, May 1, 2008, in the Bolivar Parkview Healthcare Facility. She was born in Duncan, Oklahoma, on February 14, 1929 and lived her childhood years in Springfield, Missouri. She graduated from Central High School in 1947, and from Southwest Baptist College, Bolivar, in 1950. Zodee and Beverly (Bev) Harris were married May 21, 1950. They had four children. The surviving children are Susan Harris Spurgeon and husband, Tim, of Columbia, Missouri; Steven Harris also of Columbia; and Joy Harris Crow and husband, Jerry, and children, Rebecca and Matthew of Independence, Missouri. Also surviving are one brother, Robert Pruitt of Boulder Creek, California, and one sister, Nylajo Harvey of Tulsa, Oklahoma. Preceding her in death were an infant daughter, Rebecca Ann Harris; parents, Isaac Van Buren Pruitt and Essie Davis Pruitt; and sisters, Juanita Pruitt Lumsden and Naomi Pruitt. Zodee was employed as the church secretary of First Baptist Church, Bolivar, where she was a member, before her marriage. Shortly after her marriage, she was a bookkeeper for Missouri Telephone Company in Columbia, before she became a stay-at-home mother. In more recent years, she was known first for selling Tupperware, and then Avon. Funeral services will be at 2:30 PM Sunday at Bolivar First Baptist Church with Rev. Ray Leininger and Rev. Billy Russell officiating. Interment will be in Greenwood Cemetery. Visitation will be Saturday from 6:00 to 8:00 PM at Murray Funeral Home, Bolivar.
